## Recycling



We collect household batteries for recycling. You can help by sending your old ones to the school office.

## Reminder regarding illness

If your child is away ill, it is important that you notify us as early as possible, on each day of absence, with a phone call to the school office or through your ParentMail account.

## ParentMail (Year 3)

Although you may well be receiving Parentmail emails through your email provider, please can you ensure that you **log** into your Parentmail account. This will then show us that your account is 'Active', and no longer an 'Unverified Parent'. Payments can be made through your account. Should you have any difficulties please contact the school office.

ParentMail emails will now be consolidated into one where possible and sent out at the end of the day.

## Visitors

Other than our pupils, everyone who comes onto the premises is deemed a visitor and this includes parents. Please always report to reception before going into different parts of the school.

## Change to the School Day

Starting this academic year there is no longer an afternoon play time. This brings us into line with all other schools with Key Stage 2 pupils. This allows us more curriculum/learning time to address the issues in our recent OFSTED report. It also has the benefit of ensuring that every year group has an afternoon of sport coaching.

## Cycling to School

Year 6 children who have taken the cycling proficiency course are allowed to cycle to school. It is also possible for children in other year groups to cycle if parents are prepared to cycle with them to and from school. Parents must also escort them on to and off the premises.



## School Dinners

The school meals at Burbage are excellent. They certainly represent good value for money and I recommend them to you.

Dinner money is £2.20, paid through your ParentMail account.

Children can buy a drink to accompany their cooked meal or packed lunch. Pure Fruit Juice 31p, flavoured Milkshake 40p, Mineral Water 26p, Aquajuce 31p, and fresh Milk 31p.

Children who wish to bring a drink from home to accompany their dinner or packed lunch can do so, but please, no bottles, cans or fizzy drinks.

Cartons are preferable.



## Drinks & Snacks

A reminder that we encourage children to drink water through the day. This should be plain tap water (not flavoured) in a sports type, spring top bottle. We have no facility at school to refill bottles once empty, so you may wish to send your child with more than one. Children can bring a mid-morning snack which should be fresh fruit, dried fruit, vegetables (celery, carrots etc.) or a plain biscuit. This is part of our commitment to being a Healthy School.



## Mobile Phones

Children must not have mobile phones in school. Only in special circumstances (when explained by parental letter) are they allowed on the premises. They must then be handed into the office.



## Going Nuts!

A reminder that, due to the number of children with allergies, nuts are NOT permitted in either mid-morning snacks or lunch boxes. Thank you for your co-operation on this.



## Uniform

One of the joys of a new academic year is to see the children in their uniforms, many of which have been purchased over the holidays. As always, the children look fabulous and I thank you for your continued support.

The uniform makes an important contribution to the BJS ethos and I would ask that you stick closely to the recommended items as described in the Year Group Handbooks. Uniform can be purchased from the **Hole in the Wall** shop in Hinckley or through Tesco online.

## Lost Property

Please ensure that **all** items are clearly named as a matter of priority. Without this, it is virtually impossible to reunite misplaced items with their owners. However, we always endeavour to return named lost property to its owner. Remember, we will store unclaimed, unnamed lost property for no longer than a fortnight.

The lost property box will be put outside for you to go through.

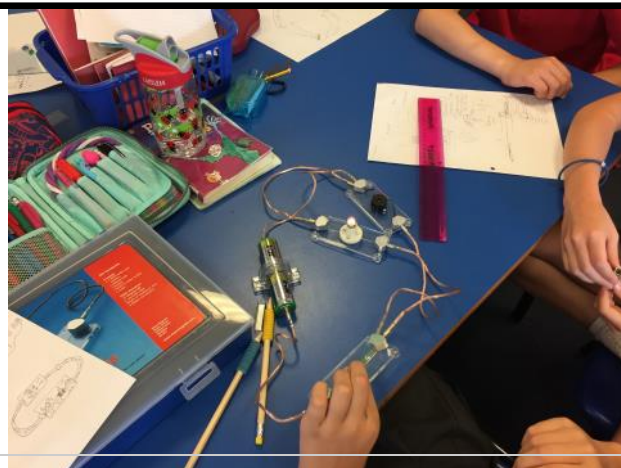
## Parental Information
